### **Small Winery Investment and Operating Costs**

The second most significant investment cost is cooperage (wooden wine barrels). Cooperage initial investment costs range from 9 to over 22 percent of investment cost for some wineries. Another relatively significant investment cost includes receiving equipment, which ranges from 6 to over 11 percent of a winery's total investment cost.

### **Minnesota's Three-Tier System of Liquor Regulation**

Wine over the Internet: Minnesota law allows the purchase and direct shipment (Minn Stat § 340A417) of two cases of wine from a winery, over the Internet, and also allows Minnesota wineries to sell two cases to a given consumer, thereby allowing these manufacturers to act as direct retailers.
